Considered one of the primary time locked cracks between the worlds, this Feast of the Dead, Samhain, marks the end, and the beginning of the Celtic New Year. In the time when the new year begins, it is believed that two different worlds come together: the world of the ancestors and the world of the living. The Celtic year does not fit together very neatly at the ends, and a person can slip from one world to

another. The other world is the one where the spirits live. It is not thought of as heaven or hell. It's just another kind of world. We will gather to remember those who have gone before us. What is remembered lives on in our hearts and souls.
